- Prices are individual, do not include meals, tickets for parks, museums, historic monuments, etc.
- Transport will be in air conditioned vehicles with guide or driver-guide speaking portuguese.

- Children: No fees for Children under 3 years of age accompanied by 2 adults.
Children between 4 and 10 years of age , accompanied by 2 adults, get a 50% discount.
- Some tourist attractions in Belém are closed on Mondays, except "Estação das Docas" and "Ver-o-Peso". So, on Mondays the city tour will be panoramic only.

Description of the tours:

1.Historic and panoramic city tour - You will go on a city tour throughout the City of Mango Trees, Belém of Pará. During this tour you will visit the most important sightseeings of our capital, among them: Basílica de Nazaré Church, Ver-o-Peso Complex (open fair, market and pier), Feliz Lusitânia Complex (Metropolitan Cathedral, Santo Alexandre Church, Sacred Art Museum, Presépio Fortress and the historical building "Casa das Onze Janelas, and the Polo Joalheiro (jewelry factory).

2.Ecological Parks - Learn about the amazon nature without leaving Belém. Have contact with the plants and sounds of the forest visiting the **Museu Zôo-botânico Emílio Goeldi**, a mix of botanic park and zoo. It is the oldest institution of research about the fauna and flora of Amazonia. You can visit Rodrigues Alves Botanical Garden (**Jardim Botânico Bosque Rodrigues Alves**) inspired by the "Bois de Boulogne" of Paris. There you will see centenary trees, waterfalls, a cave and mythological statues. Finishing this tour, you will go to **Mangal das Garças**, a modern concept of naturalistic park where you will see different kinds of vegetation. Tour estimated time: 4 hours

3.Cultural Belém - It is the best opportunity to know the culture, the history and the arts of Belém. The principal attractions are: **Teatro da Paz** (Theater of the Peace), one of the most beautiful and bigger building of the rubber boom period; **Museu do Encontro** (Meeting Museum), the place where everything began and where you will find indian pieces of pottery, a bit of anthropology, archeology and history about Pará State; **Museu de Arte Sacra** (The Museum of holy Art), one of the most beautiful and complete museum of holy art of Brazil, with its unique jesuit and indian art pieces; **Museu de Arte de Belém** (The Museum of art of Belém), there you will find the historic trajectory of Belém. Tour estimated time: 4 hours

4.Icoaraci tour - About 18km from the center of the city of Belém is Icoaraci, an attractive, antique little town on a stretch of land which is washed by the Guajará Bay. The highlight of Icoaraci is the production of pottery which is very famous and in a great demand around the world. These handicrafts are a genuine reproduction of the Indian ceramics from Marajó and Tapajós areas. There you will be able to get some souvenir and also admire the excellent work of our artisans.
Tour estimated time: 4 hours.

5.Mosqueiro Island - Located on the west bank of the Pará river, among three bays: Baía do Sol, Baía de Santo Antonio and baía do Marajó. Mosqueiro island is surrounded by a ring of beautiful and pleasant beaches of fresh water stretching out for 17km. One unusual characteristic of the Mosqueiro beaches is that it is formed by bay waters, which makes it waves even as big as the waves of ocean beaches. There is an exuberant forest in the Island cut by small rivers where the inhabitants often go for hunting and fishing.

6.Belém Coast at Sunset - Tour Length: 1 ½ hour. One of the greatest things to do in the afternoon is to sail along the Belem coast aboard the "Tribo dos Kayapós" (Tribe of Kayapó indians). During one and a half hour, in the Bay of Guajará, you will be able to observe many of our historical landmarks: The Ver-o-Peso Market Complex (Fisherman Square, the Beira Manor, the Iron Market, the City Market, the Clock Square, the Açai Fair), the castle Fortress (city founding landmark), the Old City Quarter with the Santo Alexandre Church, Sé Cathedral and Nossa Senhora do Carmo Church, the Salt Port with its typical regional boats, the Condor District (bohemian quarter); the emerald-green collar of islands surrounding the bay (Onças and Combu islands), the Moju, Acará and Guamá Rivers; the modern complex Estação das Docas (Docks Station), with its nostalgic flavor of the city old port (Port of Pará, ending the tour in front of the " Ver o Rio" (Riverside) project and from there, back to the boarding place. On the boat, a specially trained tour guide, folk dancers who will

teach you the regional dances, and live music will make the tour a very delightful one. Leaving at 17:30h.

7. Belém Boat tour city lights – Board a regional boat to enjoy the City Lights, a pleasant boat tour alongside Belém shore. It takes 1:30 hour, starting at the Guajará Bay, you will see the shore of Belém navigating through Guamá River, lullabied by live music, fun activities, presentation of folkloric dances and a tour guide. Leaving at 20:00.

8. Islands and Trails - Tour to Sirituba Island, a primitive and bucolic site. 1 1/2 hour from Estação das Docas to the Carnapijó Island, district of Barcarena. Navigating along the Bay of Guajará, heading to Marajó Island, we will pass by some isles which form the emerald-green collar of our natural patrimony: Onças, Arapiranga, and Barra Islands, Furo das Mucuras (narrow channel), where the lavish Amazonian vegetation may be seen in its full exuberance and where riverside dwellers make their living. Landing on the Island, after a 20 minutes ecological walk, an unsophisticated lunch will be served, in a very simple restaurant. Free time for swimming in the Bay of Marajó. Then, back to Belém, with live music on the boat, entertainment, regional aerobics, folk dances, and a specially trained guide. Estimated arrival time at the Estação das Docas: 4:30 p.m.
